RECEIVING COMMUNION

Following the outbreak of swine flu last summer, the Archbishops issued instructions to the Church on how Communion should be received. They stated that the Chalice should be withheld and that intinction should be banned. As the immediate threat of swine flu appears to have passed, all the new rules put in place by the Archbishops have now been rescinded. At St. George's Church you may now receive Communion as you used to prior to the outbreak but please note the following points: 1 it helps the Lay Assistants if you use one hand to guide the Chalice to your lips and please avoid leaving lipstick on the Chalice.

2 if you intinct please do not let your fingers go into the wine and make sure you don't drip the wine as you take the wafer to your mouth.

Palm Crosses Please bring your cross back to Church shortly so that it can be burnt in preparation for the Ash Wednesday service on February 17th.

Christmas Traditions Many people take their decorations down as soon as Christmas is over and others wait until twelfth night. This follows the tradition that it is unlucky to have decorations up after the Feast of Epiphany, although there is some confusion which night is the "twelfth". Some books give it as Jan 5th and others as the evening of Epiphany itself - Jan 6th. To add to this confusion most Western Churches have moved Epiphany to the nearest Sunday, and at the same time extended the Christmas season until Candlemass on February 2nd. At St. George's we follow the now established pattern of keeping Epiphany both on the Sunday and also on the day itself, and the decorations remain until Candlemass so keeping the season going. The Eastern Churches in Greece and Russia keep their main Christmas festival on January 6th when Jesus was revealed to the Gentiles. Some northern European countries have their family occasions on December 6th on the feast of St. Nicholas - (Santa Claus), so making Christmas itself a mainly Church festival.
