A time for picnics and rest in the shade...

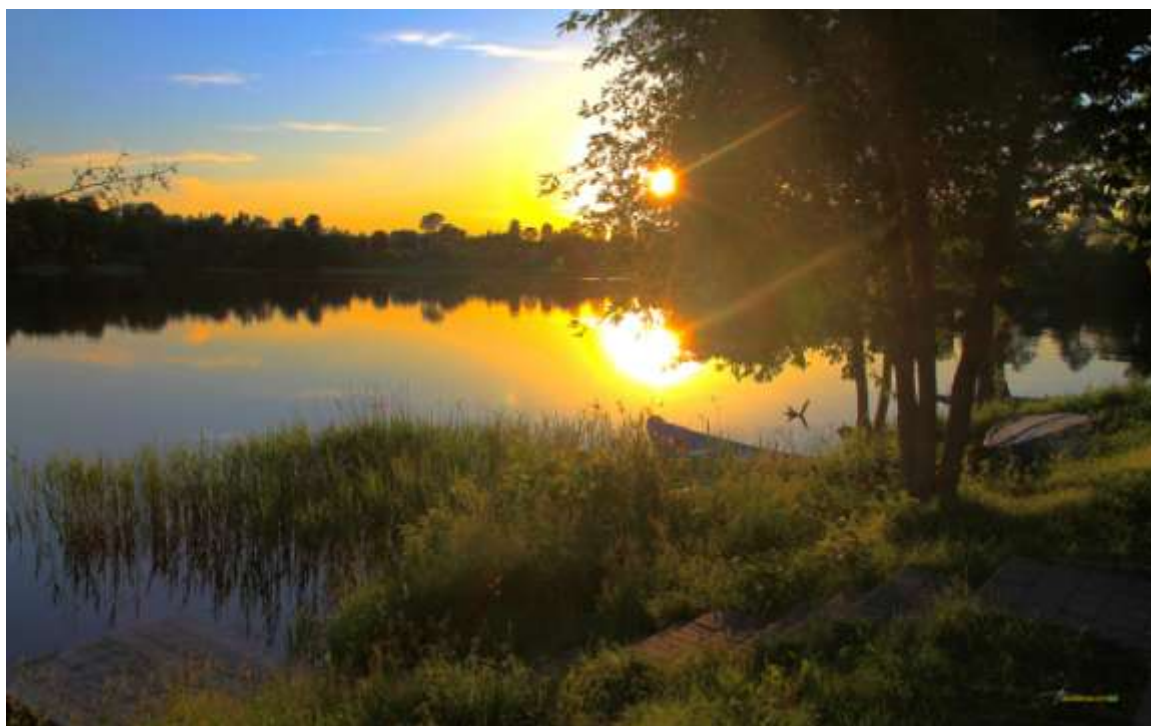
